# HOW TO DOODLE CUTE MOTHS

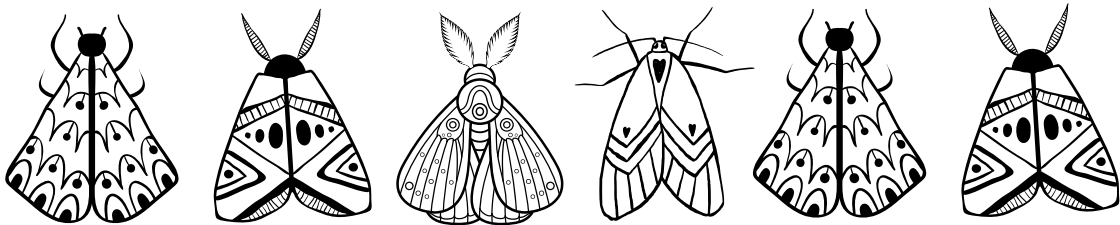


Draw an upside down heart

Add pattern and colour!

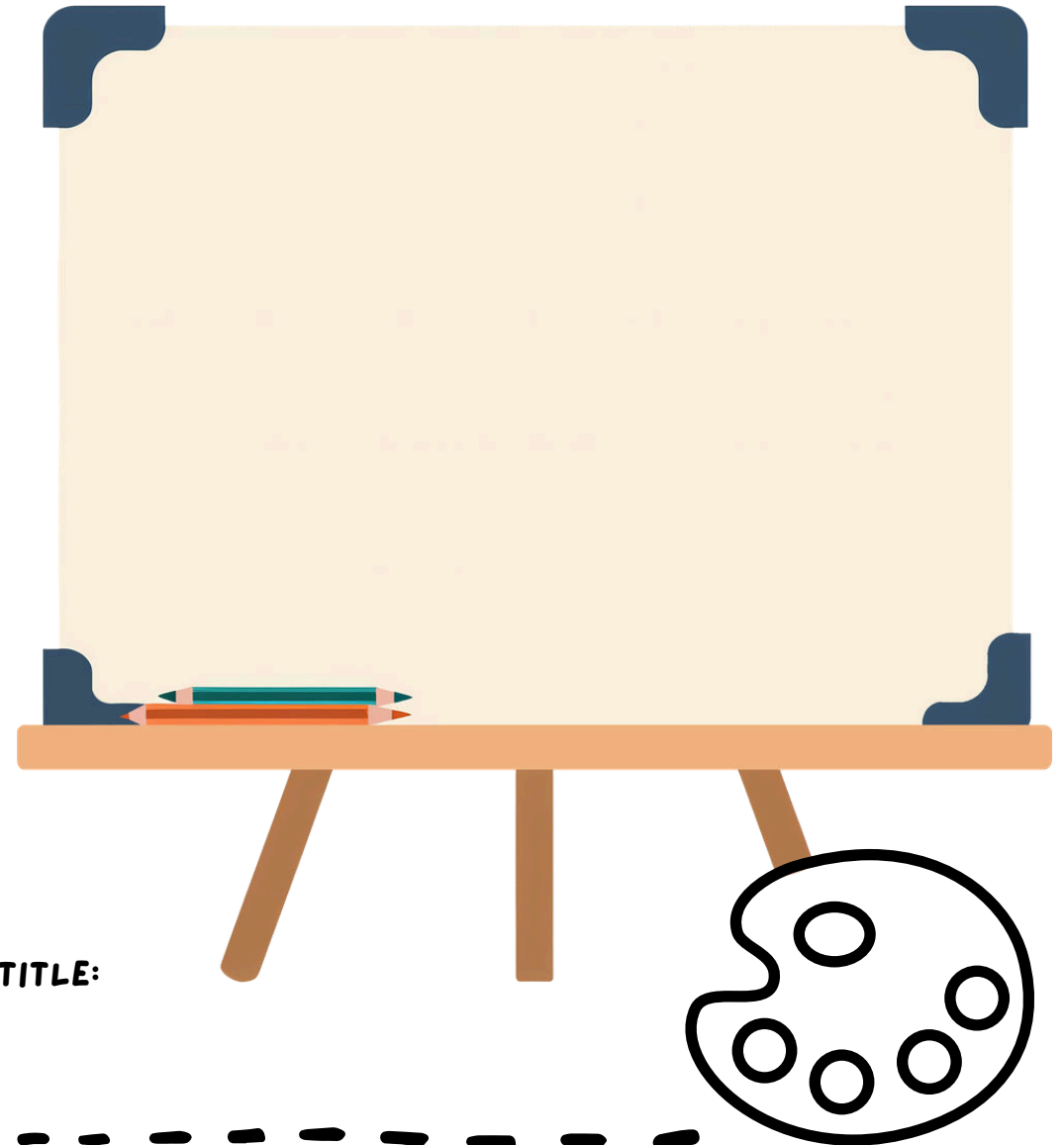
Can you create a repeating pattern of moths?

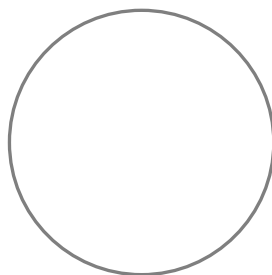
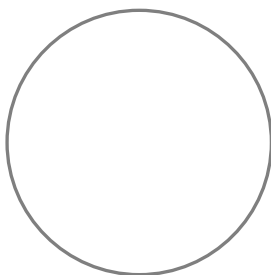
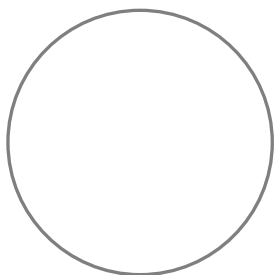
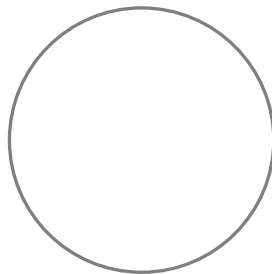
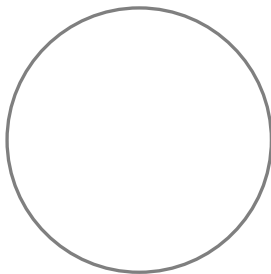
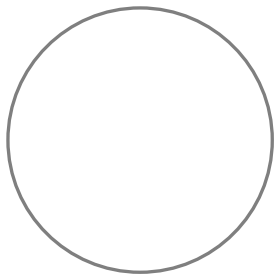
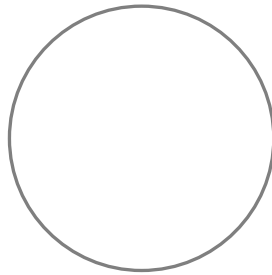
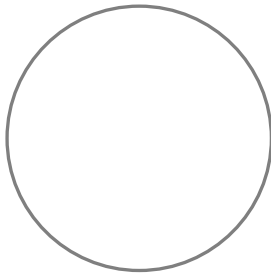
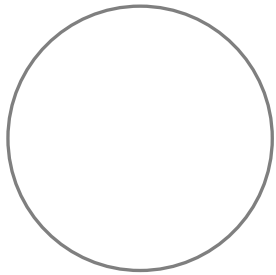
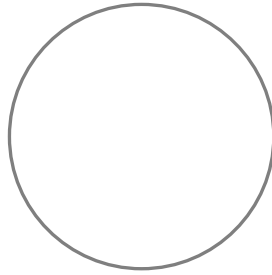
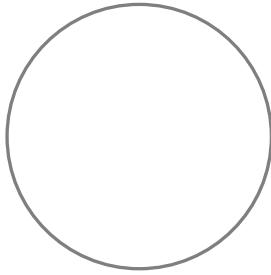
- A mosaic is a picture or pattern produced by the arrangement of lots of small materials.
